- 1. Where shall we place the name of the perit who carried out the project? Shall this be located on the boards themselves, or should they be in an envelope attached to the board? The name of the authors should feature in the submission form, office profile and executive summary, not on the posters.
- 2. Authorship and Attribution: Can credits for any relevant works (including reference to our own office) be included in the A2 posters? I am asking this as other submissions we have prepared asked specifically that no attributions or company logos should feature on the A2's.

The authorship and attribution should only feature in the Office Profile and Executive Summary.

3. Emerging Practice Award: Does practicing refer to the time since obtaining warrant or how long the particular office / practice has been operating for?

The Emerging Practice Award is intended to give recognition to the younger members of the profession. Eligibility for this award is 51% - 100% of the partners of the firm having obtained their warrant to practice as a perit after 2007.

4. Emerging Practice Award: Would works completed prior to 2016 also be eligible?

The Emerging Practice Award nominees can submit as many projects as they wish on the two A2 posters completed between 2008 and 2018.

5.	Emerging Practice Award: Are there any specific requirements
	for this category or can we submit any kind of project?
	Is there a limit to the amount of submissions we can make
	per category?

You may submit as many projects as you wish within the two A2 poster limit.

6. Is it possible to submit the same project under 2 different categories?


Yes, you can submit the same project under multiple categories. Each submission will be assessed separately against the criteria for each of the categories. You will need to resubmit the documentation indicating a different award category. Registration fee for each submission applies.

7. Should the A2 posters include only photos or can they include more information like captions, text, etc?

There are no limitations on what you can include on the posters, however details on authorship and consultants should only be included on the Office Profile and Executive Summary.

8. What happens if our submission is shortlisted?

Shortlisted nominees will be requested to make a presentation to the jurors in a public lecture. Further details will be provided to the successful nominees.
